12 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Discuss AFP Testing with provider. AFP to be done between 15-22 weeks if you wish to do it ▪ √ Fetal heart beat at each visit 	

16 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss AFP results if back Urine culture to be obtained Discuss results of 1st Trimester Screen 	
20 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review urine culture Review results of 20 week ultrasound if done Review results of AFP if done later than 16 weeks 	
24 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss 1-hour Glucose Test to be done to check for Gestational Diabetes Order blood work for Anemia Antibody screen to be checked <u>ONLY</u> if Rh negative 	
28 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review results of 1-hour Glucose Test and blood work to check anemia Discuss Rhogam injection <u>ONLY</u> if Rh negative Schedule 3rd Trimester Talk with nurse at 32 weeks Pick a Pediatrician 	
30 weeks visit with MD or provider	<p>Starting every 2 weeks visits</p>	
32 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit with OB nurse to discuss disability, labor and delivery, pediatrician, circumcision, breast or bottle feeding, and to be registered at Highland Hospital (unless already done) Discuss disability if needed 	
34 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pediatrician name 	

36 weeks visit with MD or provider	<p>Starting Weekly Visits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cervical Culture to check for Group B-Strep Prepare for a cervical exam at every visit now Possibility of spotting after exam Repeat HIV test (if indicated) 	
37 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cervical Exam 	
38 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss 36 week culture results Cervical Exam 	
39 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cervical Exam 	
40 weeks visit with MD or provider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may have a non stress test (NST) and/or ultrasound to check the status of your baby Provider may discuss and schedule induction prior to 42 weeks. Cervical Exam
